CLASSES - RING 1 (Classes may be divided if sufficient entries) **09:30 am**

Class 1* **Best Turned out Horse and Rider (ridden, lead rein optional)**

Class 2* **Best Condition (in hand)**

Class may be divided into stabled (overnight or 24 hours) and grass kept.

Class 3* **Coloured and Odd Coloured (in hand)-** All heights.

May be split by colour – Skewbald/ Piebald and Odd Coloured.

Class 4* **Youngstock: 1, 2 and 3 year olds.**

Class 5* **Veteran (in hand)**

For horses and ponies 15 years plus (born in or before 1997).

Highest within age groups 15 - 20, 21+ will qualify

NOT BEFORE 12.00

Class 6* **Coloured and Odd Coloured (ridden)-** All heights. May be split by colour

a) For skewbald and piebald horses and ponies only.

b) For palominos, duns, appaloosas, roans, spots, paints, creams.

Class 7* **Cobs (ridden).**

For horses over 148cm.

Class 8* **Veteran (ridden) –** No lead reins

For horses and ponies 15 years plus (born in or before 1997)

Highest within age groups 15 - 20, 21+ will qualify

Class 9* **Family Horse/ Pony** - No lead reins, snaffle bridle only.

Class 10* **Ridden Mountain & Moorland.** - No lead reins.

May be split between large and small breeds

Class 11* **Leading Rein Pony**

(no pony/rider combination to enter both classes 11 and 12)

Ponies not exceeding 122cm (12hh). Riders not to have reached their 9th birthday on 01/01/12. Rosettes to all entries.

Class 12* **First Ridden Pony**

(no pony/rider combination to enter both classes 11 and 12)

Ponies not exceeding 128cm (12.2hh). Riders not to have reached their 11th birthday on 01/01/12.

Class 13* **Pony Club Pony**

Ponies not exceeding 153cm (15hh) to make good all rounders for all Pony Club activities. Any suitable bit. Riders not to have reached their 25th birthday on 01/01/12

Class 14 **Minimus Working Hunter Pony**

Not exceeding 14.2hh. Ponies not to have been 1st, 2nd or 3rd in WHP classes
Jumps 2' - 2' 3"

Class 15 **Novice Working Hunter Pony**

Not exceeding 14.2hh. Ponies not to have been 1st on more than two occasions in WHP classes. Jumps 2' 6" max.

Class 16 **Open Working Hunter Pony**

Not exceeding 14.2hh. Jumps approx 2' 9"

CLASSES 14, 15 & 16: WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP for 1st & 2nd prizewinners

AFTER 12.30pm

Class 17* **Novice Working Hunter**

Horses exceeding 148cm /14.2hh. Jumps 2' 6 – 2'9"" approx.

Horses not to have been 1st on more than two occasions in WH classes.

Class 18 **Open Working Hunter**

Horses exceeding 148cm /14.2hh. Jumps approx 3' - 3' 3".

CLASSES 17 & 18 : WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP for 1st & 2nd prizewinners

Class 19* **Riding Club Horse/Pony** - For horses (exceeding 153cm/15hh) and ponies that make good all rounders for riding club activities. Ponies: riders to exceed 25 years on 1st Jan 2012

Class 20* **Ridden Hunter** Horses 153cm /15hh and above.

Class 21* **Rehabilitated Race Horses** – Thoroughbreds retired from racing and now retrained.

Registered Weatherby's General Studbook or overseas equivalent. Must have raced and can show a race record. Horses 15hh (153cm) and over. Will be expected to do a freestyle show. Blemishes not considered. Rider must have reached 17th birthday on 1st Jan 2012. Judge will not ride.

PASSPORTS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION IF ASKED FOR BY A JUDGE OR OFFICIAL OF THE SHOW

ADDAMS CATERING SHOWING TROPHY AWARDED TO OBHRC MEMBER WITH MOST POINTS.

PRIZES: Trophies, or prizes in kind, and rosettes according to entries

RULES: CHILTERN EQUINE CLINIC CTR Championships

The Championship is aimed at keen and competitive amateurs, not professionals.

Not eligible for the C&T Rider Championships:

- Horses and Ponies who have qualified for or competed at HOYS (except SEIB Search for a Star), Royal International Horse Show or Olympia in the years 2010 2011 or 2012 are not eligible for the C&T Rider Championships
- This Championship is aimed at keen and competitive amateurs and local professionals who are not competing at the top level.

Stallions must be handled and ridden by people who have attained their 14th birthday on 1st January 2012

Passports must be available for inspection if asked for by a judge or official of the show.

Qualification can pass down the line - as far as 4th place.

Judges do not award Q cards or sign cards. Correct reporting of the results of each class, indicating all CTR members passed on to CT Rider by the show secretaries, will suffice. CT Rider will then award the qualifications as per their rules and inform the competitors.

All riders who want to be eligible to qualify must be CT Rider Members. New memberships for the 2012 season are now on sale and can be purchased on line by visiting www.chilternrider.co.uk or by ringing the CT Rider offices on 01582 748981/2.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE: Please do not enter qualifying classes if your horse or pony is not eligible. You will get spotted. In 2006 AND 2007, a horse and pony were disqualified which is embarrassing and causes a lot of problems.

LEAD REINS ARE ONLY PERMITTED IN THE LEAD REIN CLASSES AND BEST TURNED OUT

AMATEUR SHOWING SOCIETY – competitors will be given a qualification slip and they will then have 28 days to become members for their qualification to remain valid. 1st – 3rd in each class qualifies.
